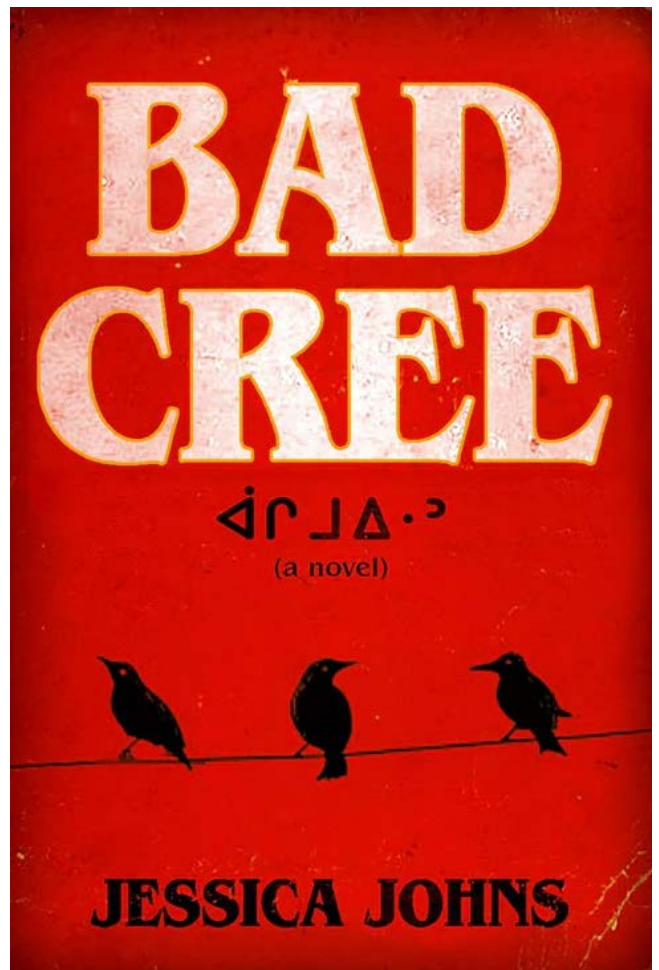

Students will engage in close readings of this work of contemporary Canadian fiction, with additional material drawn from Canadian history, geography and culture, including films and media to provide context.
